The first term of our home schooling will end on 21 May, and term two will begin on Monday, 07 June 2021.






Drop Everything And Read (DEAR)

Reminders

A child's most important cognitive development happens during their nursery school years and parent's involvement helps create more positive experiences for the child in the home and the world around the children. This strengthens a child's brain development.
